A rain garden is a low area that absorbs and filters rain water runoff that comes from roofs, sidewalks, and driveways. Rain runs off the hard surfaces, collects in the shallow depression, and slowly soaks into the soil. They are usually planted with colorful native plants and grasses. Please contact the Borough for instructions on how to plant a rain garden. If you do plant one, please ensure the Borough is notified as each rain garden planted assists the Borough with compliance to our state stormwater permit.
