

### Stormwater tip – November 2017

Polluted stormwater is almost never treated, and it can be responsible for closing fishing grounds, threatening water resources, harming natural areas, and contributing to flooding!

Fortunately, there are many ways that you can help - don't dump, wash, or rake anything down a storm drain; sweep spilled fertilizers, grass clippings, leaves or soil off sidewalks and driveways and back onto the lawn; and where possible, divert rooftop runoff onto the lawn, rather than the driveway.

Call your municipality if you see a violation, such as someone dumping down a storm drain.
