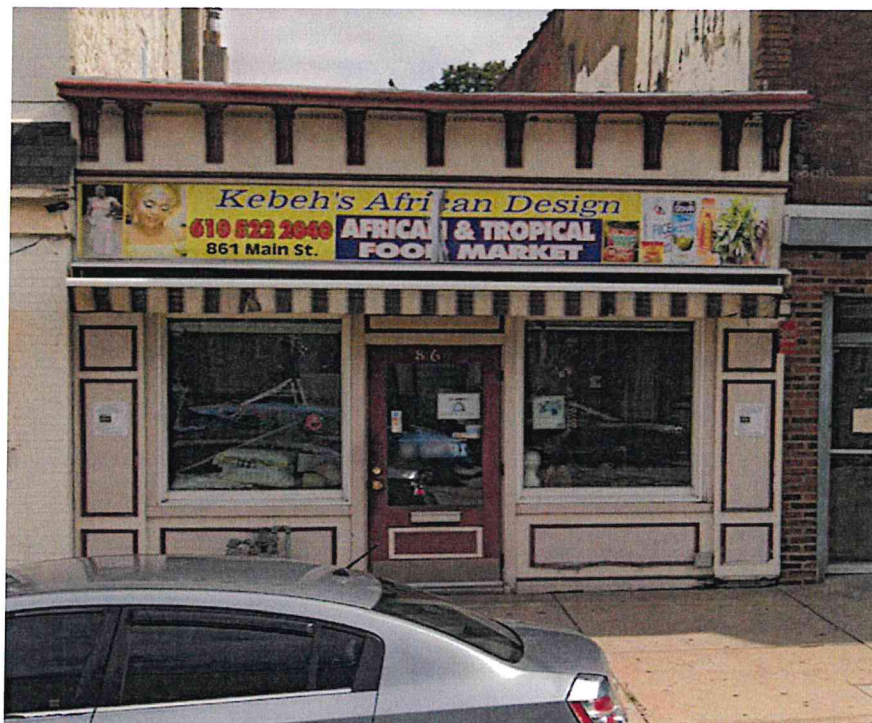

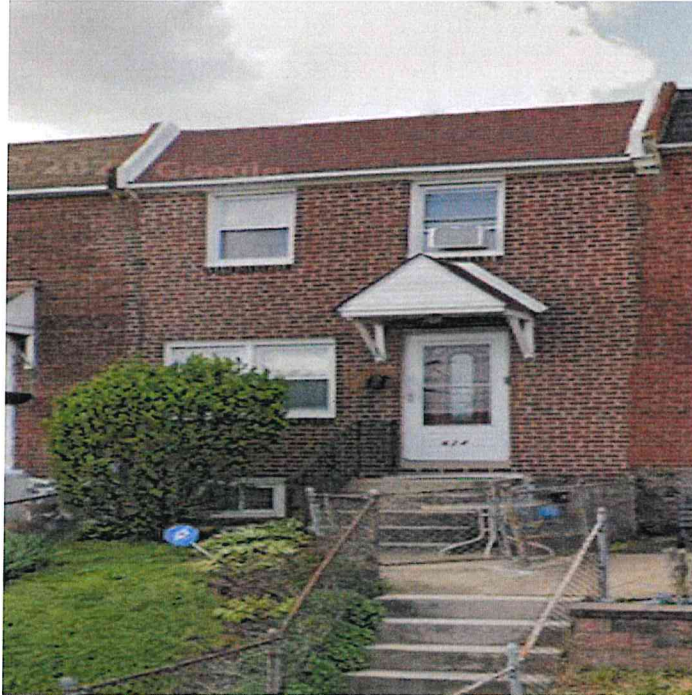

The public is encouraged to provide feedback on the levee project so that the concerns of all stakeholders can be addressed. The deadline to submit feedback is November 15, 2023.

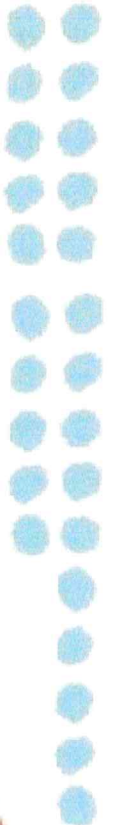
