### FY 2017 CDBG - Development of the soccer field

We have revised the bid package. The project will be advertised and rebid.

### Sanitary Sewer

We were sent a photo of a sinkhole at Concord and Main St. It is within a few feet of a manhole. Do you want to authorize the repair? We estimate it would be \$6,800 to do this repair. If the manhole requires rehab, it will add \$3,000 to the price.

### MS4 Separate Storm Sewer Permit

The Annual Report is due on September 30, 2018. Our office will reach out to the building inspector, public works department and manager regarding work or issues occurring during the past two years with regards to Stormwater and Illicit Discharges.

Has the Borough adopted the PRP agreement? The new NPDES permit will not be issued until the PRP agreement has been signed and forwarded to the DEP.

There will be a training program on Illicit Discharges in Haverford on October 4, 2018 beginning at 9AM. Registration will be required and this program is open to Borough Managers, engineers, public works and code departments. The program is free of charge. It would be beneficial to send some representatives from the Borough as this session will fulfill a requirement of the MS4 report for the next reporting year. Registration will be available shortly.

### 10 Quarry St

I have not received additional information from the geotech retained by the property owner. It is understood that the Borough rescinded the permit for the work being done as of 5/4/18. Do you want me to get the DCCD involved in this?

### Stormwater tip

Hurricane season is upon us. Did you know severe storms can cause trash and debris to flow into our stormwater facilities or drain inlets? Make sure your trash cans are in a secure location. Pick up and dispose of trash properly from your property. This will prevent unwanted trash to be sent into the local streams and creeks.
