ORDINANCE NO. 790 BOROUGH OF DARBY DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DARBY AMENDING CHAPTER 8 OF THE DARBY BOROUGH CODE RELATED TO RECOGNIZED FIRE COMPANIES

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Darby is responsible for the Borough for the health, safety and welfare of the Borough's residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council recognizes that a fully functional fire company is vital for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, Darby Fire Patrol No. 2 has failed to respond to emergency calls in the Borough; **NOW THEREFORE**, the Borough Council hereby adopts the following Ordinance.

Section 8-1: Fire Company Recognized.

Darby Fire Company No. 1, organized and existing in the Borough of Darby, Delaware County, Pennsylvania, is hereby designated the official recognized fire company of the Borough.

Section 8-4: Revenue from the Borough

Darby Fire Patrol No. 2 shall remit to the Borough an accounting of its activities for 2019. The Borough shall escrow and/or segregate all undistributed tax funds as of the effective date of this Ordinance. The Borough shall cease remitting Fire Tax revenue to the Darby Fire Patrol No. 2. The Borough shall remit Fire Tax Revenue to Darby Fire Company No. 1. The Borough shall take any action necessary to ensues compliance.

All other provisions of the Ordinance remain unchanged.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
