John Mott Drew, Sr. one of Darby's most prominent and successful African-American businessmen who started the Drew Bus line, 1919, which later became Philadelphia Suburban Transportation Company (also known as the Red Arrow Bus Lines,) his bus route and the trolley route were purchased and is now called <u>SEPTA</u>. Mr. Drew also purchased the Negro Baseball League World Champion Darby Hilldales. The Hilldales, won several eastern division pennants in the Negro League World Series against the Kansas City Monarchs. He owned the land where the Negro League Baseball stadium was here in Darby, which is recognized and marked by the Pennsylvania Historical Society with a State marker, you can visit it on Mac Dade Blvd. The team's memorabilia is now in the Negro Baseball Hall of Fame and The African American History Museum. I am requesting Council to make a change and add this great part of Darby's African American History to our Darby Borough logo.


