1. ***Our new hand held computer ticket system*** has been delivered and in operational training stages. This device will improve and expedite the process of hand written ticket violations for street sweeping, parking enforcement and code violations in our Borough. These tickets will include a photo of the violation in the event anyone tries to dispute the time place or manner.
2. ***Solar Powered Speed indicators and speed humps for our streets.*** Mayor and Council are now researching pricing for these two items. This will help slow down the problem of motorists speeding through our streets disregarding traffic signals and signs for effective safety of our residents and children.
3. ***Borough Citizens Portal.*** Mayor, Council and our Borough Manager are working with PSAB for our online portal for the convenience of our residents accessing any permits, paying tickets, or applying for anything pertaining to our Borough on line. I will have more information in the coming weeks.
4. ***Many thanks to our Planning Commission.*** They approved the go ahead construction with some waivers for our upcoming Multi Service Complex at 934 Main Street. (Old Bus Lot). This will bring jobs for residents and increase beautification on our Main Street. Job well done!

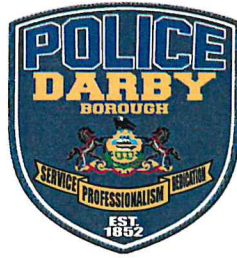

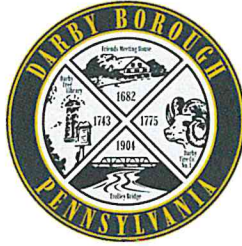

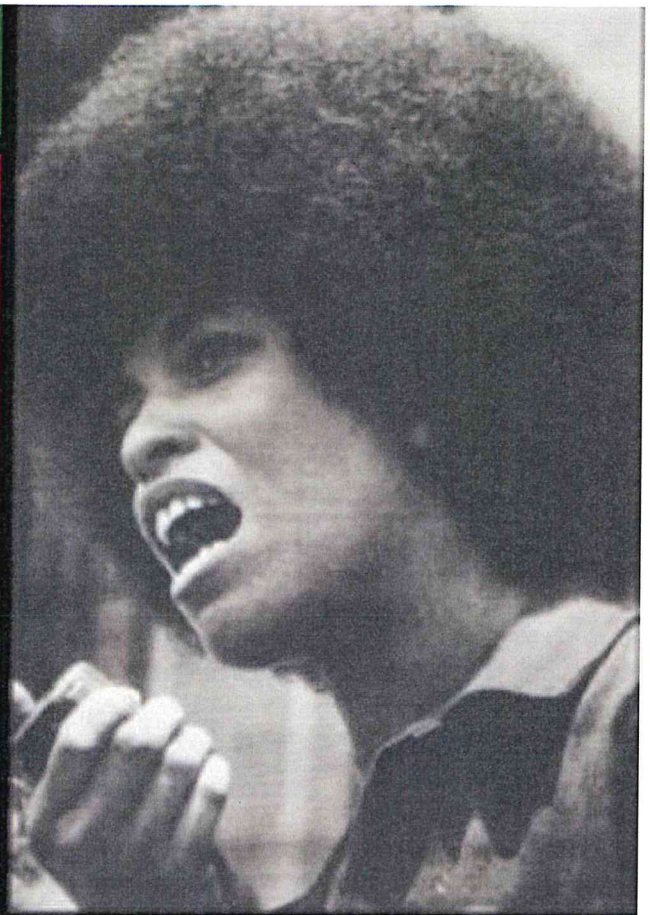
