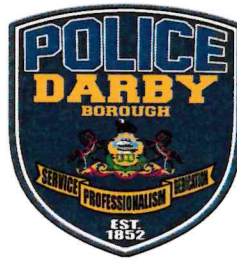

Good evening,

As we head into the summer months, the Darby Borough Police Department would like to remind our community about the importance of adhering to the Borough of Darby **juvenile curfew ordinance**. These rules are in place to protect our youth and support public safety during the months when school is out and young people may have more free time in the evenings.

The curfew applies to all individuals under the age of 18 and the hours are as follows:

- **Sunday through Thursday nights:** [10:30 PM to 5:00 AM]
- **Friday and Saturday nights:** [11:00 PM to 5:00 AM]

We understand that families may have varying schedules, so it's important to note that certain exceptions do apply. These include:

- When a juvenile is accompanied by a parent or legal guardian,
- Traveling to or from work or a school or church-related event,
- Or in the case of an emergency.

The goal of this curfew is not to penalize youth, but to **ensure their safety**, discourage crime, and encourage responsibility during the summer break.

We ask parents and guardians to please help us by:

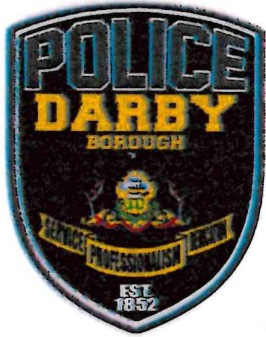
- Knowing your child's whereabouts,
- Talking with them about the curfew hours,
- And making arrangements for transportation when necessary.

Violations may result in a warning, or a citation, but most importantly, we want to **partner with families** to keep our youth safe and out of potentially risky situations.

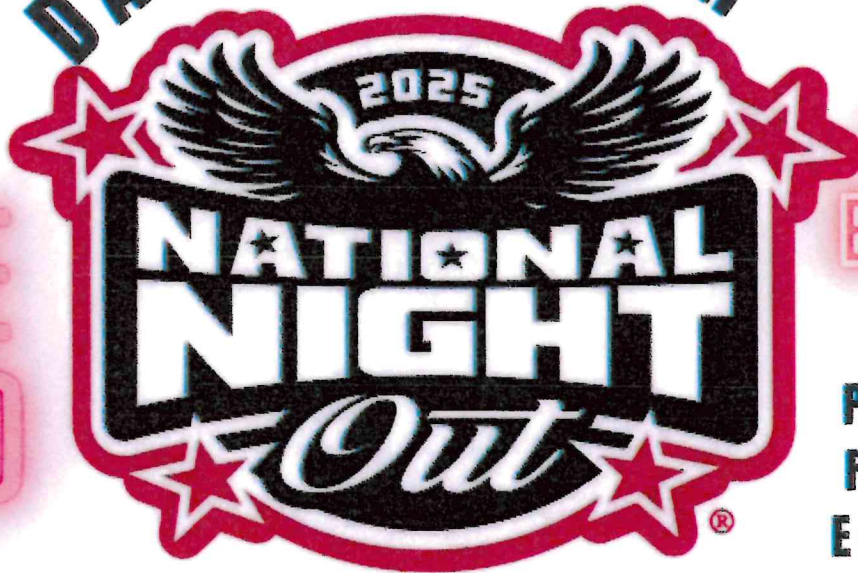

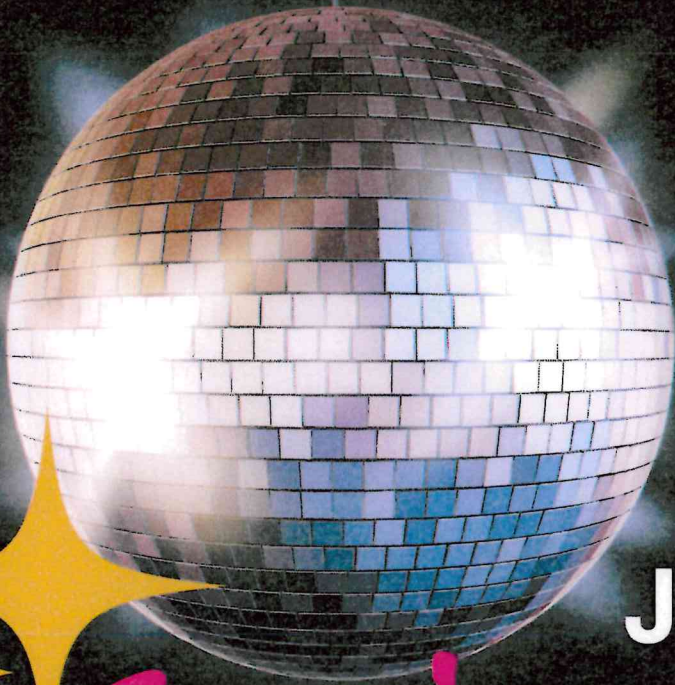
